### **Participants will:**

- Be paid an allowance equivalent to minimum wage while attending program
- Acquire skills and information on values and self-esteem, balancing life, survivability, job retention and employer expectations
- Receive certification in Smart Serve, First Aid, Safe Food Handling, WHMIS and Passport to Safety

### **Eligibility:**

- Out of school
- Out of work
- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Not in receipt of EI benefits
- Between 15 and 30 years of age

First program start date is **Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2008**  
New programs will run every five weeks
